CHAIRMAN HOFFMAN: 3 Welcome, everybody. 4 First, just a couple of standard 5 reminders that if you're recusing 6 7 yourself, which I don't think will be applicable to this meeting, from a 8 resolution, state your name and 9 organization, and why you're recusing. 10 11 If you do have a comment or 12 responding to something, please speak into the microphone. 13 And turn off your microphones who 14 are not speaking, because these can be 15 16 pretty sensitive. First of all, I wanted to welcome 17 our new Board Members, Gubernatorial 18 19 Appointees. We have Benjamin Nussbaum. 20 He's the Chief Financial Officer 21 22 for the Village of Key Biscayne, as well as a CPA and Certified Public Pension 23 Trustee. 24 25 He began his career in public

accounting before serving the last 12 years in municipal finance leadership with the City of Miami Beach and the Village of Key Biscayne.

Under his stewardship, Key Biscayne maintains the lowest overlapping millage rate in Miami-Dade County, and one of the strongest pension-funded ratios in Florida.

He lives in Palmetto Bay with his wife and three young children and is an avid soccer fan.

Welcome, Benjamin.

We also have, also a Gubernatorial Appointee, Miriam Solaire Ramos, over here. She is a Land Use and Zoning Partner at Holland & Knight, and is Board Certified in city, county and local government law.

She is an active civic leader, and currently sits on several not-for-profit boards and Florida Bar committees.

She served as President of the Cuban American Bar Association in 2022, and has been recognized by Legal Elite,

government and non-profit attorneys, 1 Super Lawyers and Best Lawyers in 2 America. 3 She earned a BS and JD from 4 University of Miami, and is a proud wife 5 and mother of two children, 21 and 17. 6 7 Welcome. And then, over here, Luis Suarez, a 8 Shareholder and Attorney for Heise Suarez 9 and Melville, P.A. 10 He previously served as a partner, 11 12 an equity partner for Boies Shiller and Flexner, LLP. 13 He served as a Commissioner on the 14 11th Circuit Judicial Nominating 15 Commission, and earned his bachelor's 16 17 degree from the University of Florida, his master's in Business Administration 18 19 from George Washington University, and his JD from Villanova University. 20 21 Welcome, Luis. 22 And I'm also happy to announce that Dr. Clara Ospina is on a reappointment 23 to our Board. 24 Welcome. 25

to Dr. Bagner, who is going to give our 1 Nominating Committee Report, the only 2 actions of item on this agenda. 3 Thank you. 4 COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER: Great. 5 Thank you, Ken. 6 7 Good afternoon, everyone. I hope everyone had a great summer. 8 Welcome back. 9 The Nominating Committee has been 10 11 very busy over the past few months. 12 are going to start first with the discussion of an At-Large vacancy that 13 actually was a result of a change in the 14 statute, creating another At-Large member 15 for our Board. 16 So the Nominating Committee met on 17 18 June 16th to review the applications for 19 this At-Large member. And after thoroughly reviewing and discussing the 20 21 applications, the Committee unanimously recommended that Dr. Danny Armstrong fill 22 23 the position. Dr. Armstrong, who joins us today, 24 25 is a Pediatric Psychologist with close

1	to 40 years at the University of Miami
2	School of Medicine. He has held key
3	leadership roles in child health
4	organizations at the state and national
5	levels. His extensive experience
6	encompasses leadership, research,
7	clinical strategy, advocacy, education,
8	and philanthropy.
9	We're honored to benefit from his
10	dedication and expertise on our Board.
11	And I'm privileged to have the
12	opportunity to make this announcement.
13	So, can I please get a motion to
14	move forward this motion to approve
15	Dr. Armstrong to fill this At-Large
16	position?
17	BOARD MEMBER SANCHEZ: Alfred
18	Sanchez. So move.
19	COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER: Thank you.
20	And a second?
21	BOARD MEMBER GERSTEIN: Second.
22	Gerstein.
23	COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER: Thank you.
24	Any discussion, comments from the
25	Board?

1	All right. Hearing none, all those
2	in favor of Dr. Armstrong joining the
3	Board as our new At-Large member?
4	BOARD MEMBERS COLLECTIVELY: Aye.
5	COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER: Any
6	opposed?
7	Passes unanimously.
8	Congratulations, Dr. Armstrong.
9	Ken, can we have the opportunity to
10	make some comments?
11	CHAIRMAN HOFFMAN: Sure.
12	COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER:
13	Dr. Armstrong, if you want to make any
14	comments, welcome to the Board.
15	BOARD MEMBER ARMSTRONG: Yes.
16	Thank you.
17	I have a long history with
18	Children's Trust.
19	I helped Dave Lawrence and Chuck
20	Hood with the original proposal many,
21	many, years ago. So it's just a
22	wonderful opportunity to join the Board
23	and be part of this amazing mission.
24	Thank you.
25	COMMITTEE CHAIR BAGNER: Thank you,

1 Dr. Armstrong. We have one other item on the 2 agenda to get through before we start our 3 TRIM. 4 And this is, as many of you know, 5 Marissa Leichter, who served our Board 6 for many, many years, has rotated off as 7 a gubernatorial nominee. And that opened 8 up the position for secretary on our 9 Board. And so Jim, as most of you 10 11 probably saw, sent down an e-mail on August 29th soliciting nominations for 12 this position. Fortunately, for all of 13 14 us, Laurie Weiss Nuell expressed interest in the position. The Nominating 15 Committee just met prior to this meeting 16 to discuss Laurie's nomination for this 17 18 position, and unanimously approved making the recommendation for the Board. 19 So with that, can I get a 20 21 nomination to discuss this item of having 22 Laurie be the secretary for our Board? BOARD MEMBER HOLLINGSWORTH: 23 24 move it. 25 Hollingsworth.

21	for now for the Nominating Committee.
22	Back to you, Ken.
23	Thank you.
24	CHAIRMAN HOFFMAN: Okay. Thank
